The aim was to gather some feedback about the effectiveness and value of the service from the freelancers who are currently listed, and to gain insight in to how the service might develop in the future.

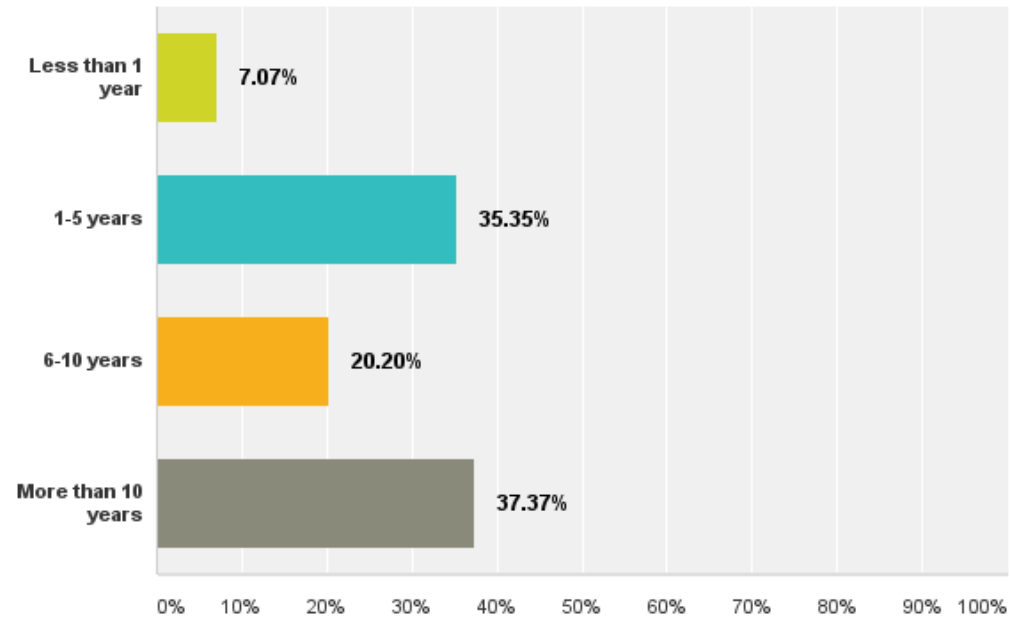
The data presented here are just some of the pooled results which will hopefully help all parties, freelancers and clients, to better understand the profile of the current service.

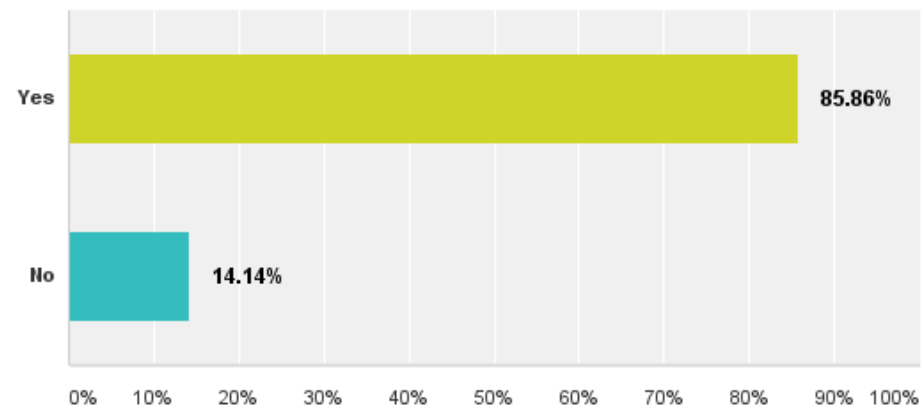

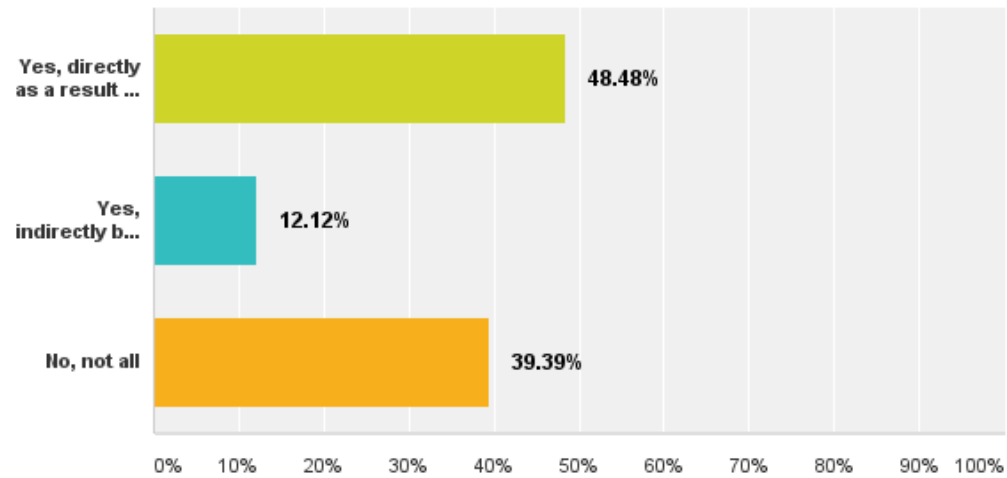

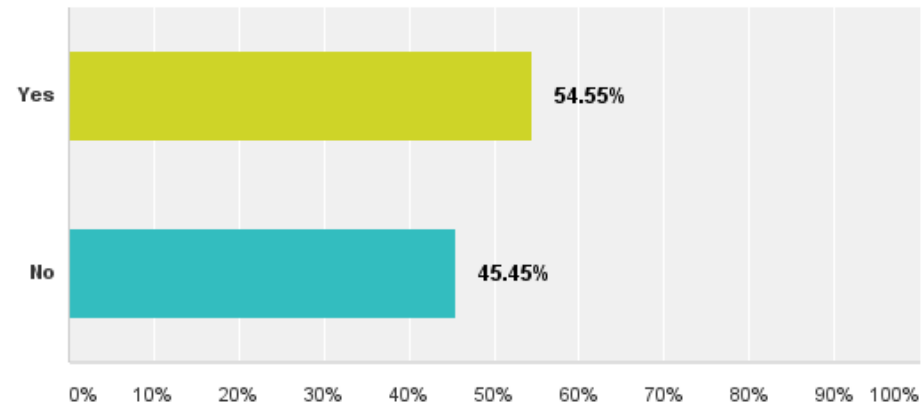
